- Inspects the construction of mechanical parts and installation.
- Prepares layouts for new machines, tool designs, plants and equipment.
- Specifies parts for laboratory scale pilot tests.
- Maintains test equipment.
- Handles gas supply and cylinders.
- Performs basic control strategies.
- Operates PLC and Labview control and data acquisition systems.
- Calibrates instrumentation for flow, pressure, and temperature measurement and control.
- Reads P&IDs (Process & ID drawings).
- Operates forklift.
- Carries out other related tasks and projects as required.

Qualifications:

- Education: Diploma in Mechanical diploma is preferred, otherwise related experience is accepted
- Experience: 2 to 5 years' hands-on mechanical work such as heavy duty machine maintenance or building, or related functions.
- Experience with machine repairs in the field is preferred
- Forklift experience and/or certification is preferred
- Ability to visualize three-dimensional objects from two-dimensional drawings
