

Job Opportunity - Production Technician

- Performs assembly, test and inspection operations to daily build schedules according to released operating instructions.
- Prepares raw materials for manufacturing processes.
- Operates various equipment and tools.
- Builds and debugs prototypes and demonstration units.
- Assists in the trouble shooting and improvement of processes.
- Inspects incoming materials and informs Team Lead of deficiencies.
- Maintains and develops associated shop-floor/quality documentation.
- Maintains the organization and cleanliness of the production area.
- Conducts procedures within health and safety guidelines, informs Team Lead of deficiencies.
- Carries out other related tasks and projects as required.

- Education: Machine/mechanical assembly courses are an asset
- Experience: 2 to 5 years' hands-on mechanical assembly, ideally in a production environment
- Some equipment operating skills but mainly hand-tools
